



INTRODUCTION

The unlimited mercy of our Guru Maharaja, His Divine Grace Srila Suhotra Maharaja is inconceivable. Through thousands of species of life, we have been wandering from the highest down to the lowest, repeatedly being harassed by birth, death, disease, old age, material nature, other living entities and our own mind.

If Srila Suhotra Maharaja had not come and pointed out to us in a way we could accept, that living in *maya* is a terrible circumstances, and that we just need Krsna, what would have become of us all?

It is inconceivable how we are so fortunate to come in contact with such a great sankirtan general so very rare on the surface of this earth, extinguishing the intolerable fire of material existence. But due to our tinge of sincerity, Krsna from within our hearts sent us a bona fide spiritual master to give us the chance to surrender unto His transcendental lotus feet. Srila Suhotra Maharaja planted in us the most valuable seed - a bhaktilatablja - he also gave us the process by which to water it as he himself writes in a letter, and I quote:

"Association with full-time ISECON devotees: devotional service, Srimad Bhagavatam and Bhagavad-gita reading and preaching and distributing Krsna's holy name, and live in Histemple - which is non-different from Vrindavana."

And on the process of how to clean out the onwanted weeds, he writes:

"We are usually very enthusiastic during our first tew years because we still clearly remember how much we suffered in karmi life. But later on, we may get lazy and bad habits can creep in again. Thus we make offences against the holy name, and lose our enthusiasm for pure devotional Then philosophical justifications for service. maya (we call it mayavada) may appear in our minds to help US re-engage in gratification. Thus we fall down. So we must always keep ourselves clean of weeds and water the bhaktilatabija very nicely",

Srila Suhotra Maharaja further writes about the process:

"So as much as I appreciated your letter, you should know that offerings of words are very easy to make. I am more interested in offerings of years - year after year of solid service to Krsna, until the bag drops dead. Prabhupada always promised us that if we simply stick to Krsna consciousness throughout this whole life time, we will surely go back home, back to Godhead. This is all by the inconceivable mercy conveyed to us by the spiritual master, who himself is a beneficiary of this mercy. So when we have received this inconceivable mercy of the spiritual master, then the greatest offence to him is to leave devotional service, the association of devotees, and again take up association of nondevotees, and re-engage in non-devotional activities. This is the mad elephant offence that destroys everything that has so nicely grown in the devotional garden."


So we should be praying to Srila Suhotra Maharaja.

"Please instruct me. Please purify me so that I will be able to assist you better and better, fulfilling the mission you received from Srila Prabhupada. Your wish is to see the society advance in Krsna consciousness and that more and more people join the Hare Krsna movement. You want millions and millions of Srila Prabhupada's books to be distributed everywhere, so please let us assist you in whatever way you want. We are simply your surrendered servants."

Our Guru Maharaja is so powerful that he can easily take us across the ocean of nescience and instructs us about how to adjust the sails to catch the favourable wind sent by Krsna. But in order to bring the boat back home, back to Godhead, we must pull out the anchor of attachment to this world, surrender unto him as our only captain, and take his instructions to our heart as our very life and soul.



THE MEANING OF VYASA-PUJA

Vyasa-puja is the Vedic tradition which goes back many thousands of years and has a deep spiritual meaning.

This day reminds us that the relationship between the disciple and the spiritual master, who is in the bona fide chain of disciplic succession coming from Vyasadeva, the literary incarnation of Sri Krsna, plays the most important part in our lives.

This reminds us that human life without accepting the pure knowledge of God via the transparent medium of the spiritual master has no value. Vyasa-puja literally means worshipping the spiritual master who is the perfect representative of the original spiritual master, Srila Vyasadeva.

Vyasa-puja is a great day of learning because as Srila Prabhupada described it: Its sum and substance is "honour and homage to the spiritual master are needed just to teach the student how to offer them to God." In this way, we can understand that accepting and glorifying a bona fide guru is the secret and the key which opens the door for the conditioned souls to the eternal life full of bliss and knowledge.

An ordinary human being cannot give us perfect knowledge because he is imperfect with four defects – imperfect senses, makes mistakes, subject to illusion and the propensity to cheat others. The spiritual master is above the four defects of a conditioned soul because he has realisation, knowledge, compassion and mercy which is derived from Krsna. The bona fide spiritual master transmits knowledge in a perfect way, exactly as he received it from his spiritual master, without any changes.

As Srila Prabhupada says in Bhagavad-Gita:

"Actually there is no difference between hearing directly from Krsna and hearing directly from Krsna via a bona fide spiritual master like Vyasa. The spiritual master is the representative of Vyasadeva also." And this is the perfect process of getting knowledge. It is similar to the way in which a postman delivers a letter. The postman does not write anything personally but he delivers what has been written by one person to another".

According to the sastras, spiritual master is the external manifestation of the Supersoul, the Supreme Personality of Godhead. By Krsna's causeless mercy, the bona fide spiritual master appears before us in a form which we are able to perceive by our material senses. But his form, words and activities are not material. He appears before us, simply to spiritualise our senses and give us understanding of our position as the eternal servant of Krsna. Therefore on this particular day, we should take advantage of this occasion and with open heart and mind pray to him to be able to completely plunge ourselves into the nectar of the transcendental instructions flowing from his lotus mouth and at the same time please the Supreme Person, Sri Krsna.

If we understand our eternal relationship with our guru, then not only will we be saved but we will be able to save others and this is the purpose of parampara – the disciplic succession in which Srila Suhotra Maharaja is the twelfth representative since Srila Rupa Goswami. Srila Vyasadeva has given us knowledge about bhakti-yoga and has established the principles of Bhagavat-dharma. Five hundred years ago, Sri Caitanya Mahaprabhu, the Supreme Personality of Godhead Himself, gave us the chance to execute sri harinam sankirtan yajna and relish the transcendental ecstasy of chanting the Holy Name.

His mission was continued by great acaryas who followed after Him such as Srila Bhaktivinoda Thakura and Srila Bhaktisiddhanta Sarasvati Thakur, who have given us the methods of purifying the path of devotional service from all sorts of deviation and hypocrisy. Then Srila Prabhupada showed us how to fight with *sunyavad* and *nirvsesa* philosophy. Srila Suhotra Maharaja in his preaching has masterfully united all this pure knowledge and methods, in order to expose and annihilate all symptoms of atheism or religious hypocrisy in modern society and establish pure devotional service to the Supreme Personality of Godhead, Sri Krsna.







Please give me your enthusiasm. Please give me your knowledge. Please give me your humility and tolerance.


Please give me the intelligence by which I can get your mercy.



you showed me - to engage with my heart and soul in the devotional service to Lord Sri Krsna.



I am utterly devoid of the knowledge on how to become worthy for even an insignificant drop of the mercy which you are so generously bestowing upon me.



Guru Maharaja, I cannot even express my gratefulness with words. My only desire is to please you.






The wheel has turned a full circle and now I hope and pray that His Holiness Suhotra Swami will give me initiation and take on this very fallen soul and give salvation.
