

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#### Introduction

Obviously, to write the introduction for Guru Maharaja's Vyasa-Puja book implies a great responsibility. I am not qualified at all for this task, but I understood that every year one of the disciples, by rotation, takes this responsibility and tries to do his best. The first thing I did was to read all the other introductions from previous years. Some of them were addressed to Guru Maharaja, others to us, the disciples. But what's the difference? It seems, this is something related with <code>sevya</code> and <code>sevaka-</code> the person served and the servant.

"Actually, however, there is no possibility of one being different from the other, for the worshiper and the worshipable cannot be separated at any stage. On the absolute platform, one cannot be understood without the other."

Now, I've got something, a thread for keeping trace of, and I started to follow it, deeper and deeper and deeper and deeper...

"All living entities, moving and non-moving, are My expansions and are separate from Me. I am the Supersoul of all living beings, who exist because I manifest them. I am the form of the transcendental vibrations like omkara and Hare Krsna, Hare Rama, and I am the Supreme Absolute Truth. These two forms of Mine-namely, the transcendental sound and the eternally blissful spiritual form of the Deity, are My eternal forms; they are not material."

"Then Gayatri, the mother of Vedas, being made manifest, i.e. imparted, by the Divine sound of the flute of Krsna, entered into the lotus mouth of Brahma, born from himself, through his right ear-holes. The lotus-born Brahma having received the Gayatri, sprung from the flute-song of Sri Krsna, attained the status of being twice-born, having been initiated by the supreme spiritual preceptor, Godhead Himself."

"But Krsna concludes, the Vedanta-sutra. Vedanta-sutra, He gives reference because this Vedanta-sutra comes from the disciplic-succession of Brahma. Brahma-sutra."

"So this is the parampara system. And everything is described in the Brahma-sutra by Vyasadeva. Vyasadeva happens to be the disciple of Narada. Narada happens to be disciple of Brahma. And from Vyasadeva, Madhvacarya; then from Madhvacarya disciplic succession, Madhavendra Puri. Madhavendra Puri was the spiritual master of Isvara Puri. Isvara Puri was the spiritual master of Caitanya Mahaprabhu. Caitanya Mahaprabhu is the spiritual master of the Six Goswamis of

Vrndavana: Rupa, Sanatana, Bhatta-Raghunatha, Sri Jiva, Gopal-bhatta, Dasa Raghunatha. So from the Goswamis, then Kaviraja Gosvami, Visvanath Cakravarti Thakura, then Jagannath das Babaji, then Bhaktivinoda Thakura, Gaura-Kisora dasa Babaji, Bhaktisiddhanta Sarasvati. And we are servant of Bhaktisiddhanta."

A big airport. Many people were coming and going. Somewhere, in the waiting area, Srila Prabhupada was waiting for his next flight. He was surrounded by some of his disciples. They all were chanting. After a time, Srila Prabhupada looking at one of his disciples, who was standing in front of him, said:

But, who was that disciple, so nicely praised by Srila Prabhupada? Of course, no one else than our beloved Guru Maharaja, so qualified to receive *sabda-brahma* from Srila Prabhupada, in that glorious above mentioned disciplic succession.

"The Vedas are known as *sabda-brahma* because evidence taken from the Vedas constitutes the ultimate understanding. This is because *sabda-brahma*, or the Vedas, represents the Supreme Personality of Godhead. However, the real essence of *sabda-brahma* is the chanting of the Hare Krsna mantra. By vibrating this transcendental sound, the meaning of everything, both material and spiritual, is revealed."

"But if you can chant Hare Krsna, then immediately you go to the spiritual planet. These are stated in the Bhagavad-Gita. *anta-kale*, at the time of death, if you can capture this sound, *Omkara* or Hare Krsna... If you capture *omkara*, then you are transferred to the spiritual sky."

"So there is a disciplic succession. That parampara should be followed. *evam parampara-praptam imam rajarsayo viduh*. If we want to understand really Vedic literature, then we must follow the parampara system."

"So one who is very serious to understand the science of God, for him a guru is required."

So let's follow our Guru Maharaja, an ocean of mercy! We are completely dependent on his grace. All glories to you, dear Guru Maharaja! All glories to your devoted disciples!



#### Meaning of Vyasa-Puja

The two words Vyasa and Puja indicates Srila Vyasadeva and the worship of Srila Vyasadeva or his representative. But why is Srila Vyasadeva so special? First of all he is an empowered incarnation (*saktyavesa-avatar*) of the Supreme Personality of Godhead, Lord Sri Krsna. He is the sage "whose words are Vedic evidence and through his words alone can the materially conditioned souls attain spiritual knowledge", as Sri Caitanya Mahaprabhu has testified to Sanatana Goswami.

And by what is so special his worship over all others? Why it is the most important celebration of the whole year for a disciple? Because the disciple can honor his spiritual master, the perfect bearer of the Absolute Truth, the true representative of Srila Vyasadeva on the occasion of his appearance day and thus show gratitude and appreciation to him and of course it is an opportunity to get special mercy: inspiration and enthusiasm for devotional service.

Surely now is coming question who is true representative of Srila Vyasadeva and who is actually bona fide spiritual master? It is he, who has first of all his spiritual master in the chain of disciplic succession and doesn't change anything on the teachings of his spiritual master.

Srila Vyasadeva has compiled vast Vedic literature for the sake of fallen souls of the age of Kali, where besides many bad qualities memory of people is cut down heavily. People of this age have short memory and are extremely spiritually lazy. But still for those who are little bit inquisitive about spiritual life, Srila Vyasadeva compassionately left those literature amongst which Srimad Bhagavatam is the jewel, "which revives the loving ecstasy of the souls inner devotion to Sri Krsna and transfers one from the material realm to Goloka, the supreme plane of transcendental consciousness, where the most intimate forms and pastimes of Godhead are revealed." (quoted from Guru Maharaja).

But because Srimad Bhagavatam is also an incarnation of the Lord, it is not possible to grasp this treasure simply by dry academic scholarship. No, on the contrary, the student must rise up from armchair and,

"Just try to learn the truth by approaching a spiritual master. Inquire from him submissively and render service unto him. The self-realized souls can impart knowledge unto you because they have seen the truth."(Sri Krsna to Arjuna in Bg 4.34)

Actually if one wants to understand Srimad Bhagavatam, to get some spiritual knowledge, he must surrender his whole life; body, mind, intelligence everything to the current representative of Srila Vyasadeva, the bona fide spiritual master, who is the most proper recipient of our love and veneration. In our Vaisnava culture it is so nicely arranged, that disciple can practically without limitations show his gratitude, appreciation and love for his spiritual master in the process of Vyasa-Puja celebration and spiritual master on reciprocation showers his mercy on disciple; actually one of the meanings of Sri Vyasa-Puja is "a celebration of the unceasing flow of mercy from our divine master" - Srila Suhotra Swami Maharaja - Ki Jaya!

And yes, everyone can understand without any doubt, that His Divine Grace Srila Suhotra Swami is true representative of Srila Vyasadeva: his vast wisdom and deep realizations of teachings of Srila Prabhupada his beloved spiritual master and Vyasa (one who describes elaborately) of the modern world, he presents in so nice form in his lectures, books, seminars and discussions. But also in his all other activities he demonstrates its effect:









#### Adhika Daya devi dasi

flourish in the morning, when the sun is rising. The lotus sees the rising sun and opens to accept it. Therefore, when the spiritual master sees the rising sun of the desire to surrender to Krsna, then his lotus feet begins to flourish to give the mercy to the disciple. The lotus is very cool. Therefore, the lotus flower cools the heart that is infected by materialism. Samsara-davanala-lidha-loka, the materialistic heart is blazing in the fire of material existence. It is blazing because of lust, anger and envy. It is the state of a big fever. Somebody is very ill. In India to reduce fever they sometimes use lotus flowers. They put the lotus on the sick person and the fever diminishes. In the same way, our hearts may be cooled when we keep the lotus feet of our spiritual master in our hearts. What else can we get from lotus? The lotus honey. There are many ordinary flowers but the pollen picked by bees from the lotus flowers creates the sweetest kind of honey. In Ayur-veda this honey is used as a remedy for the eyes.

The spiritual master is;


- the best friend.






"Gopis are clapping with their hands and Krishna dances. He is the Supreme Lord... but He dances."

Sri Caitanya Mahaprabhu says:

brahmanda bhramite kona bhagyavan jiva guru-krsna-prasade paya bhakti-lata bija

Even if one wanders for many millions of years, from the time of creation until the time of annihilation, one cannot get free from the path of material existence unless one receives shelter at the lotus feet of a pure devotee.

As a monkey takes shelter of the branch of a banyan tree and thinks he is enjoying, the conditioned soul not knowing the real interest of his life, takes shelter of the path of *karma-kanda*, fruitive activities. Sometimes he is elevated to the heavenly planets by such activities, and sometimes he again descends to the earth. This is described by Sri Caitanya Mahaprabhu as *brahmanda bhramite*. However, if by Krsna's grace one is fortunate enough to come under the shelter of the guru, by the mercy of Krsna he receives lessons on how to execute devotional service to the Supreme Lord. In this way he receives a clue of how to get out of his continuous struggle, going up and down within the material world. Therefore the Vedic injunction is that one should approach a spiritual master. In Bhagavad-Gita (4.34) the Supreme Personality of Godhead also advises:

tad viddhi pranipatena pariprasnena sevaya upadeksyanti te jnanam jnaninas tattva-darsinah

"Just try to learn the truth by approaching a spiritual master. Inquire from him submissively and render service unto him. The self-realized soul can impart knowledge unto you because he has seen the truth."

Srimad-Bhagavatam (11.3.21) gives similar advice:

tasmad gurum prapadyeta jijnasuh sreya uttamam sabde pare ca nisnatam brahmany upasamasrayam

"Any person who seriously desires to achieve real happiness must seek out a bona fide spiritual master and take shelter of him by initiation. The qualification of his spiritual master is that he must have realized the conclusion of the scriptures by deliberation and be able to convince others about this conclusions. Such great personalities, who have taken shelter of the Supreme Godhead, leaving aside all material considerations, are to be understand as bona fide spiritual masters."

Similarly, Visvanatha Cakravarti, a great Vaisnava, also advises: *yasya prasadad bhagavat prasadah.* "By the mercy of the spiritual master one receives the mercy of Krsna."





#### Kalavinka dasa

It is the same advice as given by Sri Caitanya Mahaprabhu *guru-krsna-prasade paya bhakti-lata-bija*. This is essential. One must come to Krsna consciousness, and therefore one must take shelter of a pure devotee. Thus one can become free from the clutches of matter.

I prayed to Krsna, because being just saved from the material ocean, being one of those who came in ISKCON out of frustration, I didn't understand the position of Srila Prabhupada. I looked at Krsna, not understanding who gave me Krsna and who can establish me in the service to Him, and to introduce me in His *lila*. This is very good example of ego-centrism, selfishness. I tried to jump over everything and everyone- all the way to Krsna. Ignorance! Very neophyte state coming from the fact that by the mercy of Srila Prabhupada, one surpasses many levels in the spiritual advancement. He is just taking us from the stool and placing into a *halavah*. But we don't understand what actually happened. That by his mercy we are high on the spiritual stairway. Srila Prabhupada Ki Jaya.

Then the sound of the thunderbolt came: HARE KRSNA HARE KRSNA KRSNA KRSNA HARE HARE HARE RAMA HARE RAMA RAMA RAMA IIARE HARE! It was your voice Guru Maharaja! Let me always listen to your bhajans and chant after you the Maha-Mantra.

Then I woke up completely and understood that Srila Prabhupada and Krsna sent you to take me back home. Definitely, Sri Caitanya Mahaprabhu is always giving you His association. Because, what you are doing for us - the fallen souls is inconceivable. And being extremely and unusually merciful, you are acting in a way that our debt to you is increasing. The only thing I've developed is the attraction to the mission of book distribution. I know that this is only due to your mercy. Please give me your mercy to become a better preacher and to be able to do my service with the desire to satisfy you, to give Krsna to the others, and to attain pure love of Krsna.



Guru Maharaja, in the "Nectar of Book Distribution", I've read, that it is enough only to hear Srila Prabhupada books to develop all His good qualities. I know that this process is not automatic and this can only happen by the mercy of the spiritual master. You are a bright example of these words. By the mercy of your spiritual master you obtain all of His Divine qualities.

Please be merciful to me, and give me the opportunity to develop all of your wonderful qualities and to attain such big love and devotion to you, as this you have for Srila Prabhupada.

Every time when I wrote Vyasa-Puja offerings, it was very difficult to do it. In my previous letters I wrote something, but now I don't know what to write. It is not that there is nothing to be said, but I am unqualified to do it. On such an auspicious day, when the spiritual master is glorified, I thought that one should say a lot of things. Why I cannot do it?

I remember from the Srimad Bhagavatam class, how Krsna is glorified by His devotees, how nectar is flowing from their mouth. In their prayers, they don't stop glorifying Krsna and His pure devotees. I could also try to copy this model and to tax my brain squeezing out a lot of sophisticated and flowery words and then by reasoning to arrange a few phrases for the glorification of the spiritual master. From an external point of view, the words I write could look like the words of great sages and devotees from the Srimad Bhagavatam, but only from an external point view. I realized, that there is a great difference. As I said in the beginning the great devotees recite prayers in glorification of the Lord and His devotees, but they do it directly from the heart, in a spontaneous mood. This prayers, naturally flow like nectar without any separate mental endeavor, because they are situated on the spiritual platform, the real position of the living entity. Now I can very easily understand that as long as I am situated on the mental, material platform, with such a dirty and contaminated consciousness as mine, practically it is impossible to glorify a pure devotee.

By Krsna's and your mercy, I was accepted as your disciple. In this way you gave me a great chance to choose serving Krsna instead of serving Maya.

Today is a day in which I have the occasion to thank you for this and to offer my homage unto you. Your mercy, qualities and glory, are so great that I cannot describe them by my words, even if I were a great learned speaker.





Guru Maharaja, you open the doors of the spiritual world, now it is my turn. I just have to step in, as you have said!



While reflecting on your inconceivably wonderful personality I have realized how rarely fortunate I am that I have met you. Just as Lord Brahma states in this verse:

I still remember commenting to my friend after the lecture: "This person is completely different from all the other arm-chair thinkers, just sitting in the couch, smoking a pipe, and discussing philosophy. He has such a simple and pure life and moreover he lives according to what he teaches.

Guru Maharaja, I was just an ignorant person at that time, with my consciousness so filthy from all these crazy bogus speculations. But even for me, your radiant personality did not remain covered. In you I found embodied all my ideas for an ideal spiritual person, for you are the true philosopher, the real intellectual, even the greatest eccentric. Because all of these virtues have their origin in Krsna, the Supreme Lord, they are absolute and transcendental and while manifesting through you, who are a transparent media of God, all of them remain in their pure, uncontaminated state. Thus you are without any selfish desire to draw the attention of others to you- rather all your intentions are aimed at Krsna only, and this makes you so attractive. At the same time, I must confess again how lucky and specially favored by Krsna and you I am:

"Out of many millions of wandering living entities, one who is very fortunate gets an opportunity to associate with a bona fide spiritual master by the grace of Krsna. By the mercy of both Krsna and the spiritual master, such a person receives the seed of the creeper of devotional service."

I had so many friends together with whom we were speculating about the goal of life, and who also got the wonderful opportunity to hear from you, but who remained in the ocean of nescience...

Now, as the years are passing by, with great amazement, I can observe how your wonderful qualities are increasing and increasing. Although you are the most perfect, you are becoming more and more perfect, just like Srimati Radharani who despite of being the topmost devotee, is ever increasing, ever perfecting Her love to Krsna. And the way you are giving Krsna consciousness to others reminds me the cooking of a sugar candy- it is sweeter and sweeter and thicker and thicker. Recently, you are bringing out and teaching us the most essential points of the Krsna consciousness philosophy. For your pleasure I would like to mention here three of them which I have caught from your teachings as the most important. They are explained with your own words:

#### 1. Chanting purely the Hare Krsna Maha-Mantra:

- "...We need to come to the state called *mantra-yoga*, in which the consciousness is always vibrating: Hare Krsna Hare Krsna, Krsna Krsna, Hare Hare/ Hare Rama Hare Rama, Rama Rama Hare Hare..."
- "...Our whole being should vibrate all the time. Day and night; sleeping or awake the heart should be beating- Hare Krsna, Hare Krsna,...Then our position is actually secure, because we are situated within Krsna."
- "Let us realize that our absorption in the Hare Krsna Maha-Mantra is our actual life and this is our only hope, therefore we should not take it lightly."
- -,...So this- becoming a confidential devotee of Krsna, is a very high state of Krsna consciousness, but Srila Prabhupada is assuring us, it is easily attained by the pure chanting of the Maha-Mantra."

#### 2. Serving the mission of the spiritual master, namely the Sankirtana-Yajna:

- -,...So this is actually the result of a great mercy. The mercy of the holy name. We speak of the Sankirtana mission- this is the mission of the holy name..."
- -,...We have to arrange our life in that way, that everything we do, we should direct as our service to the mission of the holy name..."
- -,...This is Lord Caitanya Mahaprabhu's heart-felt desire- that the holy name of Krsna, shall touch the life of every man, woman and child on this planet. So, when we speak of serving the holy name- this is the best service- somehow or other we should engage in pushing this movement, spreading it more and more..."

#### 3. Associating with the devotees:

-,...ISKCON...it must be very very strong movement, and the reason for this strength is because, it facilitates genuine *vaisnava-sanga*, no nonsense *vaisnava-sanga*, but the real thing that is so rare in this world...We must try, try, try to take full advantage, just meditate how rare it is..."

-,...For example in Greece, there are 9 million Greeks. And then when in the midst of this ocean of madness one can meet one or two devotees that are there- it is just a handful of devotees in that country, one feels so fortunate... Against the background of total madness, this is the only shelter..."
-,...This is my humble prayer to all of you that you kindly churn this great ocean of nectar in which you are situated- this International Society for Krsna consciousness - churn it, churn it, make it sweeter and sweeter, and then persons who are really fallen, they may be able to make advancement one day..."

-,...Our only hope is the shelter of the devotees- vaisnava sanga. That is why this movement is so special..."

I cannot help myself, but I have to admit that these statements can be classified as revolutionary. For they are meant to spark a revolution in the hearts of those aspiring devotees like me, who think this is a heavy task you want from us, this kind of preaching is too straight-forward, uncompromising with any material consideration, and finally we will not manage it anyway, in this lifetime. But for those wonderful God-brothers and God-sisters of mine, who have truly taken shelter at your lotus fcct, and have firm faith in you and Krsna, this is quite a simple matter. It means only life of SERVING THIS SANKIRTANA MISSION - THE CHANTING AND BROADCASTING THE HOLY NAME OF KRSNA IN THE ASSOCIATION OF THE DEVOTEES and at the end going back home to the spiritual world. And "there is no excuse of not doing it" as you once commented it.

Dear Guru Maharaja, my only hope however is in your great compassion towards persons with such rebellious mentality, full of false-pride, lust and sahajiya tendencies like me. As long as I simply try to cling to your lotus feet, and finally start serving you, then my position is safe. I have experienced this many times but one accident not long ago made a deep impression in my consciousness. At that time I was in some anxiety due to my attachment to a certain plan which collapsed. I happened to be on the street in front of our temple, leaving for somewhere. I was just waiting for the car's door to be open. At that moment, I saw you from the distance appearing on the balcony of your room. You turned your sight to the direction I was, standing still, just watching me. Although you did not say or do anything and despite of the distance I could understand how much you are concern with, and caring for us. Your whole person was simply emanating this. Afterwards, I was just helplessly crying for not being able to give you anything worth in return. But simultaneously I had one deep realization- that I never want to make anything which is not pleasing for you.

By your help and example I've experienced steady satisfaction that comes from seeing Krsna as the cause of all causes. "Krsna is so kind, and we've come to understand this more and more. He is really taking so good care of us and giving us more than we deserve or even need."

This is actually a real concern, and I'm a bit ashamed that I can't do more than I can. But I see the spreading of Krsna consciousness in this lost corner of Europe as a very very slow process that requires an intelligent, long-term plan and a lot of patience. Let's say, that we've started to improve the world from our home. That may not be a very great achievement if you compare it to the ambitious strategies of other countries and temples, but for us it has been the most important and inspiring step. We've become very close friends with my husband, which itself is a great wonder if you recall the rocky beginning of our stormy marriage. Who could ever have expected that we can actually work and cooperate so well together. This is essential since most of the time we are only two of us here in Thessaloniki. All this is possible because you have trained us to become stronger, more personal and responsible. By nature we are the opposite but in your patient guidance we have learnt forgiveness and tolerance. Although we don't have so much vision or power to transfuse this country with Krsna's message right now, we are confident that by working under your supervision we will ultimately realize Krsna's plan. Although we cannot see it, yet it seems that Krsna has some smart way to plough Himself in to the hearts of all of us. It may take a while though. This situation has forced us to grow up in the sense that we are not so dependent on your constant attention anymore. We can see that you are expecting us to make the simple decisions by ourselves, as well as try to work out all kinds of trivial details. Constantly we're trying to hear the sound in the heart, act accordingly and seek confirmation from you. Usually, you correct or confirm our thoughts even before we speak about them to you. ...And again, out of your causeless mercy, amazing things happen. So tolerant and forgiving you are, just as a well-wishing father unto his mischievous rascal son.






Dear Suhotra Maharaja,
