"Just try to learn the truth by approaching a spiritual master. Inquire from him submissively and render service unto him. The self-realised soul can impart knowledge unto you because he has seen the Truth."No one can be spiritually realised by manufacturing his own process, as is the fashion of foolish pretenders. The Bhagavatam says that the path of religion is directly enunciated by the Lord (Dharmum tu saksad bhagavatpranitam.) It is not possible to understand spiritual knowledge by so called academic education. The opening verses of the fourth chapter of Bhagavad Gita, teach that the ageless science of Bhakti Yoga is always received by parampara disciplic succession, that is, it is passed from one teacher to the next in a living chain; from ancient times to the present. Srila Prabhupada is best understood as one particularly effective link in this chain which stems from Lord Krishna, the Supreme Personality of Godhead. His Divine Grace A.C. Bhaktivedanta Swami Prabhupada, the modern world's greatest self-realised master, taught that people could resolve their conflicts and live together in peace and prosperity only through an essential change of consciousness, that is, by accepting Krishna Consciousness. Srila Prabhupada, with his bold spiritual vision, built a house in which the whole world can live. Harvey Cox, Professor of Divinity, Harvard University, commented, "The story of Srila Prabhupada proves that one can be a transmitter of truth and still be a vital and singular person, even in some ways "original." Srila Prabhupada is, of course, only one of thousands of teachers. But in another sense, he is one in a thousand,

In a span of 12 years Srila Prabhupada toured the globe twelve times expanding the Sankirtan movement of Sri Chaitanya Mahaprabhu. Inspite of his hectic travelling schedule he still found time to translate at least 60 volumes of Vedic texts like the Bhagavad Gita As It Is, Srimad Bhagavatham, Chaitanya Charitamrta, etc. from Sanskrit to English. He opened more than 108 temples all over the world and even founded Farm Communities, Goshalas, Gurukulas, Scientific Institutes and Book Publishing Houses. Srila Prabhupada initiated more than 10,000 disciples who have so far distributed more than 1 billion copies of his books, like Bhagvad Gita As It Is, Science of Self-Realisation, Perfection of Yoga and others.

THE PEOPLE OF JHANSI RESPONDED WELL TO THE KRISHNA CONSCIOUSNESS PHILOSPHY, SO HE LEFT HIS PHARMACEUTICAL BUSINESS WITH HIS SON AND NEPHEW AND WENT TO JHANSI. 


HE WENT TO MEET PARAMAHAMSA MAHARAJ AT JHARGRAM - A SMALL VILLAGE OF CALCUTTA.

THIS DREAM HAD APPEARED EARLIER TOO, BUT THEN HE HAD BEEN TIED TO HIS BUSINESS, WIFE AND CHILDREN.
